Indiana – Limestone Health is now accepting Medicaid patients at their Lafayette and Bloomington, Indiana clinics, in addition to accepting most major insurances.

As of October 2018, Indiana has 1,449,920 individuals enrolled in Medicaid and CHIP — a net increase of 29.38% since the first open enrollment period in October 2013.

Utilizing FDA-approved medications, in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies, clinical professionals at the centers provide medical evaluations and specialized medication-assisted treatment to individuals with substance use disorder.
